Receive a report from Peña, Swayze & Co., L.L.P. in connection with the audit of the District's financial statements for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2006, and consider taking related action, including approving the audit report, authorizing filing the audit report with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and the City of Austin;
4. Receive a report from the District's drainage channel, park maintenance and composting contractor and discuss and consider taking necessary action related thereto;
5. Receive a report from the District's general manager and discuss and consider taking necessary action related thereto, including:
 - (a) Approving the payment of bills and invoices received by the District
 - (b) Quarterly investment report; and
 - (c) Proposals for fixing well pump for irrigating park, including taking any necessary action to approve proposals;
6. Receive a report from the District's attorney and discuss and consider taking necessary action related thereto, including legal action regarding restrictive covenant enforcement;
7. Receive a report from the District's security patrol contractor;
8. Receive a report from the District's solid waste disposal contractor;

9. Discuss and consider taking necessary action regarding any revisions to the District's Restrictive Covenant Enforcement Policy;
