Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Springwoods Municipal Utility District will hold a regular meeting on **Tuesday, April 8, 2008, at 6:00 p.m.** at 9117 Anderson Mill Road, Austin, Texas, for the following purposes:

5. Receive a report from the District's drainage channel, park maintenance and composting contractor and discuss and consider taking necessary action related thereto, including considering Proposal No. 7027 for Spring Color Installation 2008;
6. Receive a report from the District's general manager and discuss and consider taking necessary action related thereto, including approving the payment of bills and invoices received by the District;
7. Receive a report from the District's attorney and discuss and consider taking necessary action related thereto, including legal action regarding restrictive covenant enforcement;
8. Receive a report from the District's security patrol contractor;
9. Receive a report from Klar Communications regarding the District's website, newsletter, services summary and other communications;

- 14. Discuss and consider taking necessary action regarding CASE Conference 2008 and request for contribution to CASE lobbying fund;

Discuss and consider taking necessary action regarding design and construction of (i) the regional storm water drainage facilities and related improvements including approval of payment request and (ii) the miscellaneous drainage channel improvements contemplated under the Fourth Supplement to Revised Agreement Concerning Springwoods Municipal Utility District including Interlocal Agreement with Wells Branch Municipal Utility District and Consent and Waiver of Conflict of Interest;

If the Board of Directors determines to go into executive session on any item on this agenda, the Presiding Officer will announce that an executive session will be held and will identify the item to be discussed and provision of the Open Meetings Act that authorizes the closed or executive session.
