4. Receive a report from the District's drainage channel, park maintenance and composting contractor and discuss and consider taking necessary action related thereto, including:

 - (b) Proposal 7446, Sand Volleyball Perimeter Grading & Turf Replanting Phase F;
5. Receive a report from the District's general manager and discuss and consider taking necessary action related thereto;
6. Receive a report from the District's bookkeeper and discuss and consider taking any necessary action related thereto, including payment of bills and invoices;
7. Receive a report from the District's restrictive covenant enforcement officer;
8. Receive a report from the District's attorney and discuss and consider taking necessary action related thereto, including legal action regarding restrictive covenant enforcement;
9. Receive a report from the District's security patrols contractor;
10. Receive a report from Maxwebs Co. regarding the District's website, newsletter, and other District communications and discuss and consider taking necessary action related thereto;


TAX AND BUDGET ITEMS

11. 2009-2010 budget and 2009 tax rate, including:
 - (a) Budget for fiscal year 2009-2010, including Resolution Adopting Budget;
 - (b) Conduct a public hearing and discuss District's 2009 tax rate;
 - (c) Take record vote on the District's 2009 tax rate and adopt Order Levying Taxes;
and
 - (d) Amended and Restated Information Form, if necessary (2009 tax rate);

DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

12. Discuss and consider District restrictive covenant enforcement, including revised Resolution Adopting Amended and Restated Rules relating to Enforcement of Restrictive Covenants and form notice letters;
13. Discuss and consider renewal of Security Services Agreement with Emerald P.I., Inc.;
14. Discuss and consider taking necessary action regarding the District pool and maintenance, repairs and improvements to the District pool facilities, including discussing and considering establishing a District Dog Day at Springwoods Pool;
15. Discuss and consider taking necessary action regarding maintenance, repairs and improvements to the District park, including replacement of District office roof;
16. Discuss and consider taking necessary action regarding revised Order Establishing Rules and Regulations Governing Recreational Facilities and Fees and Charges for the Use Thereof;
17. Discuss and consider taking necessary action relating to the District's MS4 permit, including:
 - (a) Annual report implementation items; and
 - (b) Stenciling storm drain inlets;
18. Discuss and consider taking necessary action relating to the Strategic Partnership Agreement with the City of Austin regarding annexation of the District and continuance of the District as a limited district, including:
 - (a) Planning for additional special meetings; and
 - (b) Submitting inventory of service and facilities for Property within the District to the City; and

The Board of Directors is authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, to convene in closed or executive session for certain purposes including receiving legal advice from the District's attorney (Section 551.071); discussing real property matters (Section 551.072); discussing gifts and donations (Section 551.073); discussing personnel matters (Section 551.074) and discussing security personnel or devices (Section 551.076). If the Board of Directors determines to go into executive session to discuss any item on this agenda, the presiding officer will announce that an executive session will be held and will identify the item to be discussed and the provision of the Open Meetings Act that authorizes the closed or executive session.
